Associate Professor Robert Socha, PhD – Director of the Center for Cross-Border Security Research, devotes his scientific work to the use of drones in the area of security. For several years, increased interest in unmanned aerial vehicles, commonly known as drones, can be observed. The Police, the State Fire Service and other entities that care for our safety on a daily basis are increasingly turning to the expanding offer of new unmanned solutions. It is certain that the array of the main functions of drones for our safety will continue to expand.

Robert Socha is the initiator of numerous research projects with the participation of WSB University students, for example „Police in Poland and Portugal – mission, tasks, and organization” project on the functioning of the police in Poland and Portugal, which was initiated with the participation of WSB University student Wiktoria Kolano (President of the Scientific Safety Association in Cieszyn). The research assessed the impact of police operations on the security of citizens of both countries by means of interviews with Polish and Portuguese police officers and with the representatives of the government in Portugal.
